NEW ZEALAND'S EDUCATION SYSTEM

SCHOOLS

Based on the prestigious British education system, New Zealand's schools offer a high quality education that encourages students to think for themselves and prepares them for further study and the working world.

A variety of options is available for primary, intermediate and secondary study including both single-sex and co-educational schools, state-run and privately funded schools, and some schools with a religious affiliation. This allows you to choose the best school for your needs, while the quality of teaching is consistently high.

The qualification earned by secondary graduates in New Zealand is called NCEA, National Certificate in Educational Achievement. Some secondary schools also offer additional qualifications such as Cambridge International Exams and International Baccalaureate.

Most school students live with a homestay family, who will make the student a member of their family during their time in New Zealand. Some secondary schools also offer boarding options in hostel accommodation where meals are provided.

TERTIARY EDUCATION

UNIVERSITIES

There are eight universities in New Zealand offering a wide range of degrees at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels. All of the universities are research-based, and New Zealand institutions place consistently highly in international rankings.

All New Zealand universities are state owned, and must meet strict quality standards. This means that no matter which university you choose, you will get a quality education.

POLYTECHNICS AND INSTITUTES OF TECHNOLOGY (ITPs)

New Zealand's 21 Polytechnics and Institutes of Technology offer practical training in a huge variety of subjects. Their qualifications range from certificates and diplomas right through to postgraduate degrees.

Qualifications from an ITP can often be transferred to other institutions including universities in New Zealand and other countries. Since all New Zealand ITPs are state owned, the courses all meet the standards set by the New Zealand Qualifications Authority.

PRIVATE TRAINING ESTABLISHMENTS

There are many privately run institutions around the country offering qualifications in career-related subjects including business, IT, travel and many more. Often these courses can lead to a qualification more quickly than a university or ITP course.

To accept international students, all of these Private Training Establishments must have their courses up to the standards set by the New Zealand Qualifications Authority.

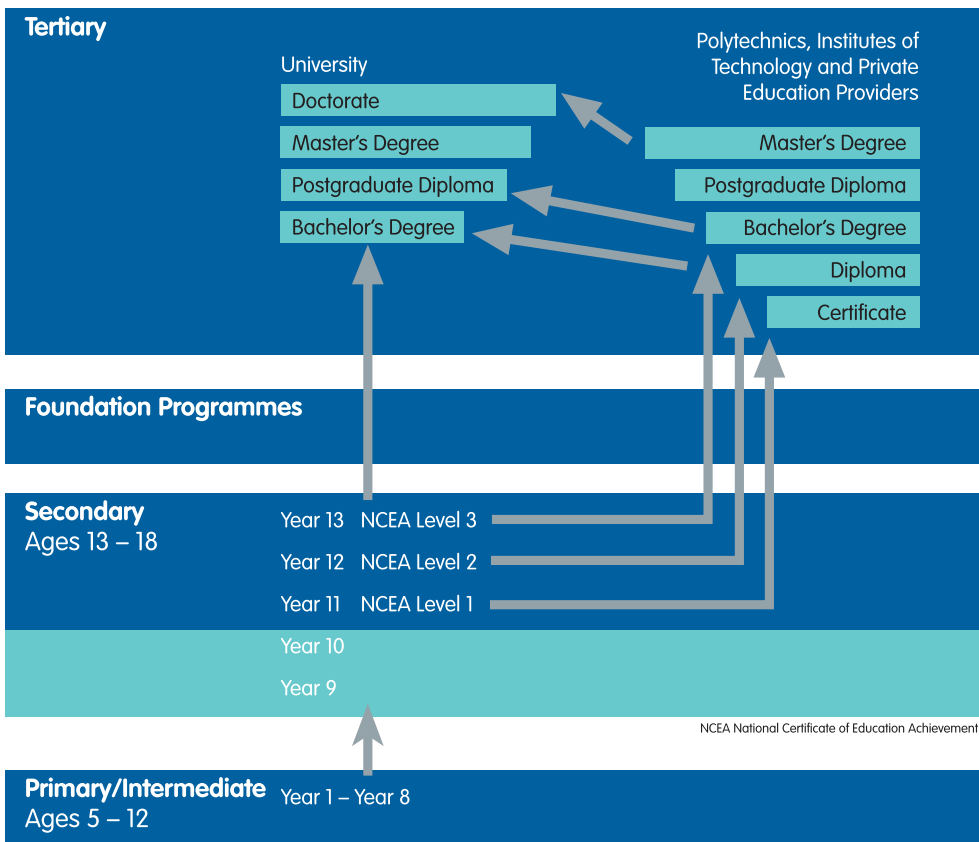
ENGLISH LANGUAGE STUDY
